The Carson Trey Styron Foundation was established in memory of Carson Styron after tragically losing him in June 2016. Carson was a determined young man who loved everyone, treated all with kindness & respect and embraced life with open arms. He was a born leader, top-notch baseball player (proudly wore #24) and athlete, played the tuba and was Student of the Year at Surprise Lake Middle School. Carson would have graduated from Fife High School in 2020 and had the ambition of attending college and playing in the MLB.

Available Scholarships:

Fife High School Scholarship: One (1) \$2,424 scholarship is available for a senior attending high school at Fife HS.

Washington State Scholarship: Four (4) \$1,024 scholarships are available for seniors attending high school at any school located within Washington State.

Scholarship Guidelines & Instructions:

- * Seeking graduating seniors with a record of community involvement either in non-school sponsored activities and/or participation in extracurricular school activities.
- * Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plan to attend a 2 or 4-year college or technical school.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid in December 2018 or January 2019 for the second semester of the student's first year directly to the college and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the foundation at that time an invoice for second semester tuition and fees, student ID number and college information.
