All monies collected will be used to meet our foundations goals of:


- Providing scholarships to students and student athletes in high school for college expenses

The Carson Trey Styron Foundation was established in 2016 by Nate and Carley Styron to honor the life of their thirteen-year-old son, Carson Trey Styron. Carson was an adventurous, loving, loud, outgoing, caring, and determined leader who would do anything to make people laugh and smile. He was also a top notch baseball player and excellent student, who was set to enter 9th grade at Columbia Jr. High School. Tragically Carson was taken from us on June 5, 2016 as a result of an ATV accident.

The goal of The Carson Trey Styron Foundation was to create an institution that actively touches the youth and surrounding communities with its work and to focus on the celebration of Carson's life, not his death. As a result, this foundation is not about fighting a particular cause, but rather, it is focused on how we can inspire leadership and determination through the game of baseball, while also bringing communities together. Through this foundation, we will honor Carson's legacy by taking direct action to help children in need by supporting their dreams and helping them reach their full potential.

Our aim is to utilize collected donations to provide annual scholarships for youth players that will cover little league fees and select/club fees, and to establish scholarships for general high school students and student athletes. We also plan to use a portion of the donations to improve upon existing ball fields and to add activity areas that will encourage families in our communities to get out and enjoy the sport that Carson loved so dearly.
